Notice is hereby given of Five (5) cruiser mooring vacancies, for which the committee invites applications from eligible members. (This notice will also be displayed on the general notice board of the Clubhouse).

Allocation will be in accordance with current club rules see:-  
Rule 12 (j) and General Regulations (appendix A)

The moorings are for vessels of

- a) Non-metallic construction.
- b) 5 moorings for craft of not more than 26 ft absolute overall length.
