## **Notices**

### **1. Safety**

Sailors/ competitors must wear personal flotation devices at all times when afloat.

The crew of a boat is entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore and nothing, whether in any Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.

It is for the crew of the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in the conditions in which she will find herself. By launching, the crew confirms that she is fit for those conditions and that they are competent to sail and compete in them.

Sailors/ competitors are expected to be capable of self-rescue. The Organisers (Tewkesbury Cruising and Sailing Club) are only able to provide normal safety patrol boats during racing and, in the event of adverse conditions, the helm and crew as well as dependent upon age the parents and Guardians must decide whether they or their Child is sufficiently competent and must ensure that their Craft is seaworthy and has adequate safety equipment.

The Club has a strict policy with regard to the safety of children at the club and reminds parents that the safety of children is the responsibility of the parent or guardian bringing

them to the Club. Thus the responsible adult should not leave the Club whilst their child is on Club premises.

## **2. Insurance**

The boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2,000,000 underwritten by an ABI Member Company or Lloyds of London whilst racing.

## **3. Liability**

Nothing done by the organisers can reduce responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death, or personal injury however it may have occurred, as a result of the crew and/or the boat taking part in the racing.

“The organisers” encompasses everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beach masters.

The provision of coaching and or safety patrol boats does not relieve the crew on the boat of their responsibilities.

Members of the Club, their guests and visitors use the Club premises and any facilities of the Club entirely at their own risk and impliedly accept that.

The Club will not accept liability for any damage to or loss of property belonging to members, their visitors or guests to the Club and:

The Club will not accept any liability for personal injury arising out of the use of the Club premises, and any other facilities of the Club, or out of participation in any races organised by the Club, whether sustained by members, their guests or visitors, whether or not such damage or injury could have been attributed to or was occasioned by neglect, default or negligence of any of the officers, committee or servants of the Club.
